• Ensure your new roof has proper ventilation to prevent moisture buildup, which can lead to mold, rot, and premature roof failure. Discuss ventilation options with your contractor.

• Consider Energy Efficiency:

• Explore options like reflective roofing materials that can help lower your energy bills.

• Act Quickly on Leaks:

• If you notice any leaks, address them promptly to prevent further damage to your home.
